(Early Start) Family Resource Centers ((ES)FRCs) empower families raising a child with a disability or who are “at risk” of developing a disability, through information/education, referrals, and parent-to-parent support. (ES)FRCs in Los Angeles County have formed a network called the Family Resource Center Network of Los Angeles County (**FRCNLAC**). Their mission is to support and promote the development, expansion, and sharing of resources among the (Early Start) Family Resource Centers in Los Angeles County. Their goals are:

- Ø To facilitate the referral of families and professionals to their local (Early Start) Family Resource Center.
- Ø To promote parent/professional collaboration at all levels.
- Ø To share resources and educational materials.
- Ø To share training activities and educational opportunities.
- Ø To support countywide public awareness and outreach.
- Ø To coordinate a unified and consistent representation to the Family Resource Center Network of California.
- Ø To explore the development of a centralized telephone referral system for all families residing in Los Angeles County.

The purpose of the California Association of **Family Empowerment Centers (FECs)** is to provide information, resources, technical assistance, and systems change advocacy for a statewide network of local FECs who provide family education, empowerment, and parent-professional collaborative activities for families of children with disabilities ages 3-22 years old. <http://cafec.org>

Community Parent Resource Centers (CPRCs) serve families of children and young adults from birth to age 22 with all disabilities: physical, cognitive, emotional, and learning. They help families obtain appropriate education and services for their children with disabilities; work to improve education results for all children; train and inform parents and professionals on a variety of topics; resolve problems between families and schools or other agencies; and connect children with disabilities to community resources that address their needs.

Parent Training and Information Centers (PTIs) are authorized in Part D of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and are funded by the U. S. Department of Education, Office of Special Education Programs. Each PTI is mandated to assist parents to-

- A. better understand the nature of their children's disabilities and their educational and developmental needs;
 - B. communicate effectively with personnel responsible for providing special education, early intervention, and related services;
 - C. participate in decision-making processes and the development of individualized education programs (IEPs) under Part B and individualized family service plans under Part C;
 - D. obtain appropriate information about the range of options, programs, services, and resources available to assist children with disabilities and their families;
 - E. understand the provision of IDEA for the education of, and the provision of early intervention services to, children with disabilities; and
